1. Open House	Parents and children are welcomed into McGuffey to meet the staff and learn about the Title I Reading program.
2. Columbus Children's Theatre & "Read Around the Room" Event	Parents have the opportunity to watch a Columbus Children's Theatre performance with their child. Afterwards, parents & their children were invited into our gym where they could move freely throughout different literacy-themed stations. The stations were interactive and some were make-and-take activities. Parents learned ways to work with their children at home. The stations centered around the big five-phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary and comprehension.
3. Pancakes with Santa	Families can enjoy an optional pancake dinner sponsored by the PTO along with fun-filled literacy stations. Families can move throughout the stations freely. The stations are holiday-themed, interactive and make-and-take activities that demonstrate ways parents can work with their children at home to support their reading development.
4. 3rd Grade AIR Test Prep for Parents	Parents will attend an hour long meeting with the third grade teachers and a Technology Specialist. Parents will get to experience the sample online AIR test to better understand what is expected of their third grader.
