



NCS- Digital: Thinking About Going Digital?



Are you thinking about going Digital? NCS-Digital provides a public education for 1st-12th Grade Students in a digital setting. Please read through the day to day life of an NCS-Digital student before committing to digital.

- * **Students are required to be online, with cameras on, 7:40 - 3:00 every day, Monday-Friday.**
- * Each class is hosted on Zoom and students are REQUIRED to attend class at the designated day & time.
- * Daily attendance is taken during Morning Meeting as well as each period.
- * Our "OMG" (Owning My Grades) classes are student support classes. Teachers are taking attendance and available to support students completing school work. Cameras are required to be on and you will be working on schoolwork during this time, whether it is class assignments, homework, or a Plato class, like Health or Financial Literacy.
- * If you are a high school student that is deficient in credits, your credit recovery program is the same as Newark High School, which is PLATO.
